

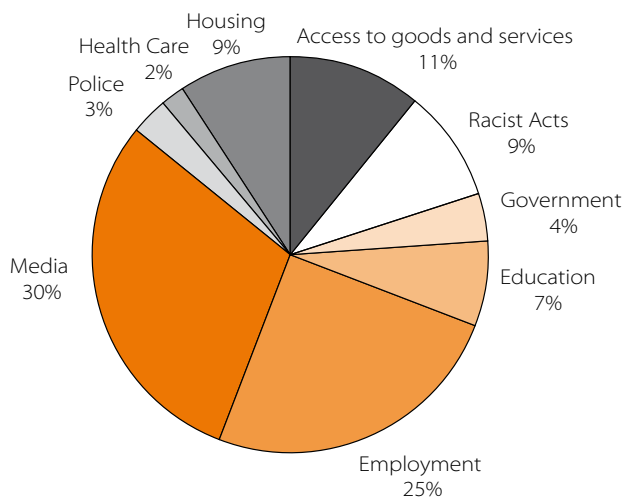


3. Presentation of broken down data

Presented below are the data from the 11 cases of discrimination gathered during 2008, broken down by the area in which the discrimination has occurred, the victims' gender and age.

By area:

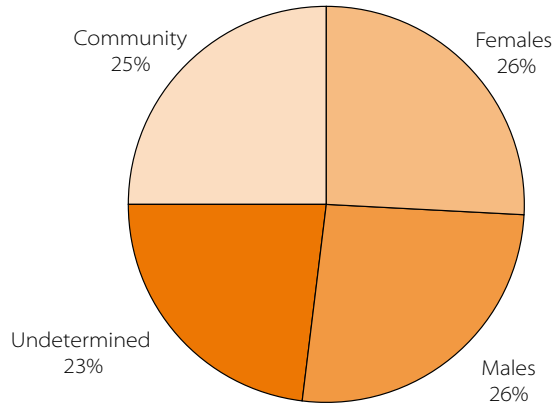
- Access to goods and services: 12
- Racist acts: 10
- Government: 4
- Education: 8
- Employment: 28
- Media: 34
- Police: 3
- Health care: 2
- Housing: 10





By gender:

- No. of cases with identified victims: 46
 - Total number of victims identified in the 46 cases: 70
 - Number of female victims: 35 (+ 3 cases with an undetermined number of victims, all female)
 - Number of male victims: 35
- Number of cases with an undetermined number of victims: 31
- Number of cases where the victim is the Roma community as a whole: 34



By age:

- Victim from 0 to 15 years old: 22 (plus 5 cases with an undetermined number of victims, but all between 0 and 15 years of age)
- Victims from 16 to 30 years old: 28 (plus 3 cases with an undetermined number of victims, but all between 16 and 30 years of age)
- Victims from 31 to 45 years old: 17 – Victims from 46 to 60 years old: 1
- Victims over 61 years old: 2
