

In 2009 over 620 consultations were made at the Documentation Centre, 30% from outside users (Roma associations, students and researchers, different public and private entities from the area of social action, media, NGOs, etc. Many of the in-house consultations made were for the implementation of FSG activities and actions in many other territories together with other social entities, schools and training centres and different public administrations.

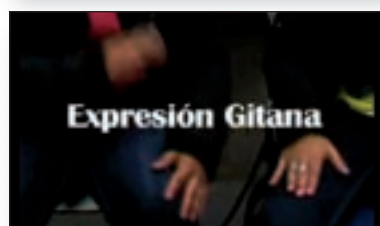
