Last school year, 96 Roma students from the Promociona+ programme graduated from their non-compulsory course. This means that the success rate of the Fundación Secretariado Gitano's educational programme is 84%. A programme that contributes to educational equality.

The number of students in the Promociona+ programme has been increasing. There were 145 students in 2017, and, in the 2020-2021 school year, there are already 448 young Roma students receiving support from Fundación Secretariado Gitano in their non-compulsory studies

Most of the students are female: 184 females and 129 males.

INTERMEDIATE LEVEL

The majority of students opt for intermediate-level vocational training cycles.

UNIVERSITY SUCCESS

86% of students in a university programme graduated. Many enrol in the postgraduate certificate from UPNa on engagement with the Roma community.

The vast majority of young Roma who come to Promociona+ for guidance and support study at the intermediate level, followed by non-compulsory secondary education, university studies, higher-level vocational training cycles and, to a lesser extent, post-graduate and doctoral studies

The Promociona+ programme is present in 44 offices of the Fundación Secretariado Gitano and in 13 autonomous communities in Spain.
