



Last school year, 96 Roma students from the Promociona+ programme graduated from their non-compulsory course. This means that the success rate of the Fundación Secretariado Gitano's educational programme is 84%. A programme that contributes to educational equality.

The number of students in the Promociona+ programme has been increasing. There were 145 students in 2017, and, in the 2020–2021 school year, there are already 448 young Roma students receiving support from Fundación Secretariado Gitano in their non-compulsory studies





YOUNG ROMA WOMEN

Most of the students are female: 184 females and 129 males.



INTERMEDIATE LEVE

The majority of students opt for intermediate-level vocational training cycles.



IINIVERSITY SUCCESS

86% of students in a university programme graduated. Many enrol in the postgraduate certificate from UPNa on engagement with the Roma community.

The vast majority of young Roma who come to Promociona+ for guidance and support study at the intermediate level, followed by non-compulsory secondary education, university studies, higher-level vocational training cycles and, to a lesser extent, post-graduate and doctoral studies

The Promociona+ programme is present in 44 offices of the Fundación Secretariado Gitano and in 13 autonomous communities in Spain.
