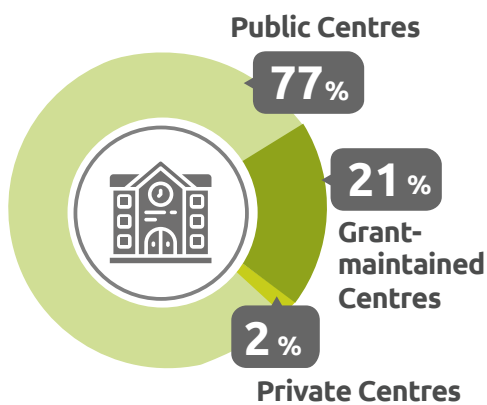

We carry out individual educational guidance with 100% of the Promociona students and their families

1 637 students in 100 Promociona support and educational reinforcement classrooms.
