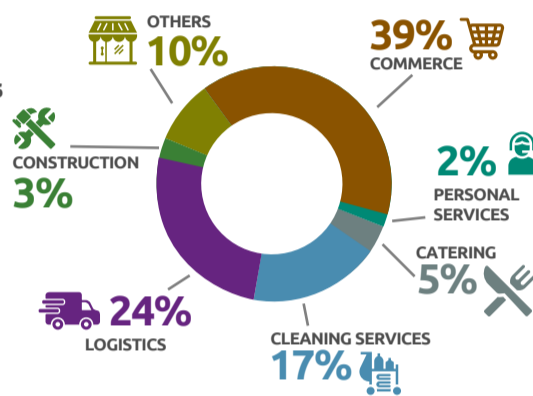

is an employment training initiative which combines theoretical and practical training in real work environments. It contributes to innovation, high quality, social engagement and competitive value.

369 participants

We focus on the return to education and on obtaining the school graduation certificate.

391 young people enrolled in Compulsory Secondary Education
