

And what about you, do you dare to share your dreams?


MARIO. YEARS OLD


Although it is not the same as being at school, Mario also likes speaking with his teacher and learning via the computer as they have done for months.

Now I like school a lot more, and I have many friends and from here I send my teacher Carmen big hugs and kisses".









Nicu is a very well-mannered, respectful and kind child.He likes macaroni and cheese, and paella.

'I feel really good at school, and over the first few days I became friends with everyone. What I like the most is that they play with me and I with them. Every time I need them, the teachers are there. When I grow up, I'd like to be a photographer because I like photography. Or if not, a firefighter so that I can help others".



Besides basketball, what Alex likes most is playing card games on his mobile phone. His mother says that he is really happy at La Ería school (Oviedo), and that he is already 100% Asturian: although they speak Romanian at home, he prefers it here to in Romania.

"My first day at school was good. Araceli was the best teacher, but I don't see her. I signed up to football and I don't like it, but afterwards I signed up to basketball which I do like and I still play. I made friends and I liked it when we went to the Philharmonic Theatre. We went twice, but I liked it more in 38".












CRISTINA. YEARS OLD
